## Survey Questionnaire

- a) Our Questionnaire was changed a little bit in question six (in comparison with earlier surveys). The question has not regard to the next EuroTier but to the next VIV-Europe-2014. The huge number of positive votes underlines the compliance with the ShowCo policy.
- b) We asked not only members. 7 participants (of 42) are non-members.
- c) Two of the non-members voted “Don’t know” regarding participation at the VIV-Europe-2014. One non-member voted “No”.

### Participant comments.

- 1) Wireless service were poor – automatic disconnect after 10 minutes of no activity. Very inconvenient.
- 2) Internet could be free of charge
- 3) EuroTier was ok., the number of visitors was less then expected but the quality was good. Possibly, the fact that the Poultry Halls of EuroTier-2012 was far away from the main entrance made that less people found this hall. Also the fact that we also have Atlanta and Bangkok and Moscow in the coming 6 months made people decide not to come to EuroTier 2012.
- 4) We don’t know – but we believe that EuroTier exhibition is more important than the VIV-Europe. Why not having a EuroTier (for poultry) every 2 years?
- 5) Generally we would prefer every 2 years EuroTier-Show (with World-poultry-Show) as the only one Premium-Show in Europe. We don’t need really a VIV-Utrecht-Show!
- 6) Because of the location of the halls there were not many “pig- and cow- visitors” passing. That was much better as before. All passing people were potentially interested.
- 7) Normally the DLG organization has a very high standard in the organization of the EuroTier fair. This time there has been a lot of failure in the communication on all levels.
- 8) We will not be in this hall (8) again.
- 9) We prefer participation on EuroTier-2012 instead of VIV-Europe-2014.

Continuation:

- 10) Wi-Fi access was available in the halls, however, at a very high price. The organizers should consider providing complementary access to all exhibitors. If this is not possible, then at a much lower and affordable rate.
- 11) The show organizer should try to find broker and agreement with a number of hotels in order to secure more reasonable accommodation prices for participants.
- 12) Extremely bad Wi-Fi connection.
- 13) The show was (as expected) very good. Especially Tuesday and Wednesday were very busy. Thursday was good and Friday was very low. We would like to suggest to go to Tuesday – Thursday (3 days).
- 14) Hotel accommodation was not always easy to book. Show itself was organized very well. We like to maintain our presence at European exhibitions in line with ShowCo. (Non-member).
- 15) Unfortunately in 2014 we will have to consider the participation to both, EuroTier and VIV-Europe. Since our company is providing equipments for all agriculture industries and not only for poultry we might not stay away of one of the two. (Non-member).
- 16) Free Internet connection for the exhibitors is highly recommended.
