It would be very good to have the show in March.

Maybe more efforts should be done to attract visitors from Africa.

Number of visitors seems to us decreased in comparison to 2016 !! We have to discuss why ? Exact information from VIV organisation for visitor number 2016 vs. 2018 is needed! First day and last day of show 2018. The number of visitors are < 50% in comparison to second day! The number of visitors on afternoon on third day was bad! Shifting the date of VIV-MEA has to be discussed !!!

Most probably too much shows in general. Abu Dhabi for most of the visitors is a destination to fly to. If you need a flight you can choose this year between VIV MEA, VIV Europe or Eurotier.

The show in 2016 was better when it comes to price-performance ratio. Could be that the "news-effect" had some influence. We will participate next time also - but probably with a smaller stand.

Expected a little more visitors turnout, especially for the second day. Overall impression is positive, the fair is still a reference event that brings together many people in the poultry sector of Middle East.

It is necessary to have more marketing activities and support from Organizer to invite delegations from different Countries (particularly from African Countries)

We had difficulties to find someone who can help our problems during preparation of our booth. We faced disrespectful attitude and replies to our e-mails were late and not helpful. Better staff for organisation would be good.

In General much more exhibitors and ground space of the exhibition. Compared to the last show two years ago I felt less visitors in the poultry equipment area.

It seems like Abu Dhabi is not as attractive as Dubai is. We expected more visitors from Africa because they have a good access to Emirates.
